After a few years some of us felt it would be better to widen our scope, so we changed our name, became the Women's Fellowship and welcomed all of any age or creed, keeping the original Christian concept. Meetings are held monthly, usually on the third Wednesday, in the homes of members in an informal atmosphere. We have had some excellent speakers and most interesting demonstrations as well as visits to places in the surrounding district. Our July meeting usually takes the form of a mystery car trip.
