WOMENS PROTECTION LECTURE

Those of us who attended this lecture, found it to be of interest and full of useful advice. We thought that those who were unable to attend, might like to hear some of the more practical hints or precautions that were highlighted:

* When going out don't put your keys in your handbag but keep them in your pocket, so that you can quickly gain access to your car or home. * Before going out, clear your handbag of longterm and precious items, so that if your handbag is snatched you will not feel you have to resist the offender, knowing that your most important belongings are safe. * Remember if you do feel the need to carry an alarm, keep it in your hand, but best of all use a torch with a built-in alarm. There are a number of inexpensive varieties on the market and these can be obtained from most D.I.Y. stores. * Don't forget, in the case of an actual attack, making a lot of noise is a big deterrent.
