

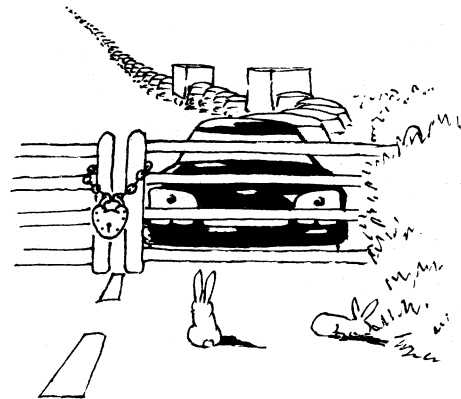
SOULBURY CONSERVATION AREA
