PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

At the recent Parish Council meeting the Clerk reported that there were no further developments over the disputed ivy growth on the Great Brickhill Road. As it is now becoming something of a hazard to the safety of both pedestrians and motorists, it was felt that concerted action from the Parish Council and our County Council representative was needed to achieve a solution to the problem.

The Parish has again been invited to enter the Best Kept Village Competition. The Council however declined the offer this year as it felt that the very neat and tidy principles, which the judges used as criteria, did not suit Soulbury at the moment.
