

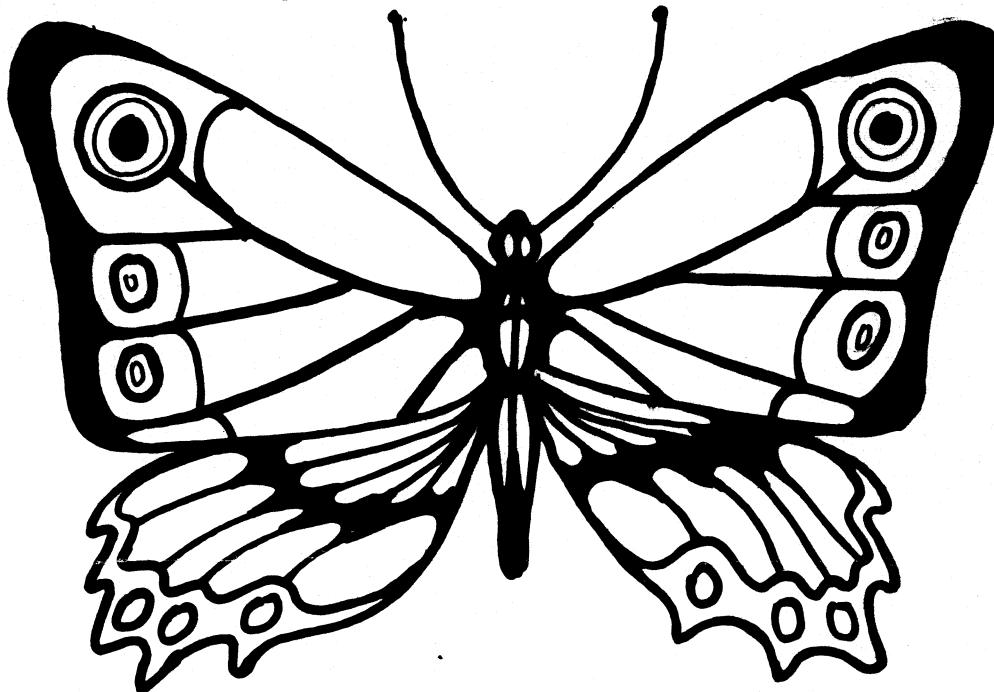
CHILDRENS HOLIDAY COMPETITION
