School Transport

As most parents will no doubt have read in the local newspaper, Bucks County Council intends to go ahead with plans to charge parents for school transport as from September 1980, unless there is strong opposition to these proposals and unless alternative ways can be found of raising or saving money. As we are a rural community and most children are transported to a school out of the village. Soulbury would be particularly hit. It is thought unfair to place an undue stare of the public expenditure cuts on villages, like Soulbury, whose own schools have been compulsorily closed and that the local Education Authority should be told to find other and fairer ways of obtaining the money! A charge which falls only on parents by the accident of where they live cannot be right. It is said that the cost would be in the region of £1-50p per week per child, but how long would it be before the Authority increased this figure again and again.

If you are concerned about this charge being implemented please come to the Clubroom on February 13th at 8.00pm. A discussion will be held as to how we can best draw the attention of local and national representives to the unfairness of

these proposals, and in particular how they would affect us in Soulbury.
