December has seen a great deal of activity in the fight against the proposal to site 4 x 410ft wind turbines at Dorcas Lane, and a summary of these events will shortly be delivered to you. Included will be **a letter**, the content of which we hope you will approve, sign and send to the AVDC.

The letter relates to Dorcas Lane and covers some new issues raised by the latest documents submitted to AVDC by the joint-developers Force 9 Energy (F9E) / Électricité de France (EDF). Because F9E / EDF have submitted more data to AVDC we need you to write this additional Letter of Objection.
