#### THE STORY OF COLLEGE LAKE WILDLIFE CENTRE : Talk by Graham Atkins

Graham Atkins is Manager of the Pitstone Fen Nature Reserve near Tring. Formerly a chalk quarry for cement it is now a remarkable 9 acre wildlife refuge harbouring a variety of mammals, butterflies, birds and plants - including orchids. It is a magical place. Building on this success, Graham Atkins persuaded Castle Cement, owners of Pitstone Fen, to undertake a joint development with BBONT to restore 80 acres of disused chalk quarry. The result is possibly the most exciting new nature reserve in the country - College Lake. College Lake has already won a major award for this initiative and is strategically placed to become a site of national importance. The talk will be on Friday 3 March at Mursley.
