Owing to lack of space, the following recollections from Mrs. Barnes had to be omitted from our June issue. She recalled that Soulbury had twice been visited by Royalty this Century; once, when the Princess Royal lunched with Mr. and Mrs. P. E. C. Lovett at the Cottage and on another occasion when the Duke of Windsor, at the time Prince of Wales, sustained a broken collar bone in one of the fields of the Lovett estate whilst hunting with the Whaddon Chase.

Mrs. Barnes also recalled some of the other notable people who have had connections with Soulbury, amongst them Sir Bernard Spillsbury, the famous pathologist, who frequently stayed at 'Thatches', then the home of Dr. and Mrs. Crossley-Holland; Miss Gwen John, sister of Sir Augustus John, R.A., who lived at the School House for a while in the 1920's. A more recent visitor was Sir John Betjeman who, with his daughter Candida, came to the Farish Church at the time of the third London Airport threat.
