Breast Screening Programme. Stoke Mandeville Hospital have acquired a suitably equipped vehicle which will visit the areas in the Aylesbury Vale Health District. Mr. & Mrs. Miller of Chapel Hill have kindly offered to provide necessary facilities for the equipment and medical staff so that the vehicle can park on Chapel Hill. Further information will be published when the Doctor and Officer in charge have finalised the programme.

Heavy Goods Vehicle Traffic. The Buckinghamshire County Council (Wing & Soulbury)(Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1984, came into operation at the end of May.

Recently Parish Councillors and parishioners have reported that a large number of HGV drivers who stop and turn at points in the village are lost, having been misled by traffic signs in Linslade. Other drivers do not turn but decide to get out of their difficulty by using the prohibited C20 road.
