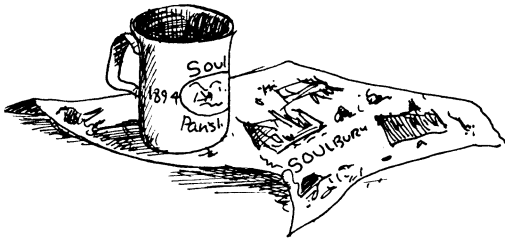


Centenary Celebrations
