Message from the Rev. Philip Derbyshire:

Dear all,

In this Jubilee month as we remember 60 years of Queen Elizabeth on the throne maybe it's appropriate to consider something of what it might mean to be British, or possibly more usefully British-ness. It's certainly about buying into certain unspoken values but also about being open enough to accept tolerantly those who might hold a different but potentially complementary set of values: a sense of fairness, of justice for all, of even-handedness. A bit like our constitution, not written but acknowledged somewhere deep in our national psyche. Even though we are aware of human frailties we are genuinely outraged by overweeningly greedy corporate leaders continually feathering their nests as more and more people fall into the poverty trap. Or openly corrupt politicians, even though we've always known they exist---we just never knew on what scale. Subscribing to a Christian foundation and heritage for our society whilst acknowledging the right of others to believe in God and worship in their own way (or indeed no way). Conversely we feel aggrieved when it's only Christians and Christian values which become the butt of foul-mouthed comedians and cynical columnists whilst these individuals lose their bottle when it comes to those of other faiths---this is of course a form of patronising behaviour.

Possibly at root it's all about the fact that a teenage girl called Ashleigh and a dog called Pudsey can win Simon Cowell's 'Britain's Got Talent'. We may not go for OTT shows of emotion but we sure love a cute sentimental dog story with loads of 'Ah! factor'!

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The Parish Council meeting took place in the Parish Hall on Monday 21st May at 19:00. The next meeting is on Monday 18th June at 19:30. All are welcome.

Annual Assembly: The annual Parish Assembly meeting took place at 8:00pm after the regular Parish Council meeting. The chairman gave his report and thanked all the parish councillors for their hard work and efforts over the past year. He recollected some of the work that had taken place during that year, not forgetting their involvement with the Paul Newman Homes proposed development of 900 houses, and the Dorcas Lane proposed wind turbine development. For the next year, Victor Wright was elected as Chairman of Soulbury Parish Council and Maurice Cross was elected as Vice Chairman of Soulbury Parish Council.

Jubilee Beacon Lighting: In celebration of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, we will meet at the beacon on the village green on Monday 4th June between 21:30 and 21:45 to toast Her Majesty, The Queen. The beacon will be lit at 22:01, which is our official lighting time. All are welcome at this occasion.

Jubilee Gift: Currently the Jubilee mugs are scheduled to be delivered after the Jubilee weekend. However, this situation may change and we may be lucky to receive them just prior to the weekend. Either way, we will endeavour to distribute them as soon as they are received.
