Concessionary Bus Fare Permits/Railcards.

The AVDC's scheme for Concessionary travel will be continued for the next financial year, and the new permits to be issued in connection with the scheme will be valid from 1st April 1982 until 31st March 1983. The cost of a new permit will be £3 for the full year and £1.50 if issued after the 1st October 1982, and it will enable half-fare travel to be obtained on seven days a week on buses only for any journey which commences or terminates within Buckinghamshire excluding the area of Milton Keynes.

The Council has decided that as an alternative to the half-fare bus permit scheme eligible persons may obtain a £10 Railcard for 50p which will entitle the holder to purchase Single, Ordinary Return and Awayday railway tickets at half the adult fare.

It is stressed that you may have either the Bus Permit or the Railcard, but not both under the Council's scheme.

Permits and Railcards may be obtained from the Council Offices at Aylesbury, Buckingham or Winslow on or after 9th March 1982.
