Police Inspector Flynn, Sergeant Kitchen, and Pc Mc Sweeney attended the Parish Council meeting on 24th February. Pc Mc Sweeney is now responsible for Soulbury, Hollingdon and Stewkley.

The main items discussed were Neighbourhood Watch, speeding, lorry traffic and police presence in the village. The police are prepared to help with reinstating the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme and to this end Pc Mc Sweeney will be attending a meeting to be held in the Club Room on Wednesday 11th March at 7-30 p.m. Please be present to hear what we can do to help ourselves in preserving

'Law and Order'. We shall need co-ordinators for various parts of the village, but we want to see a good turn-out apart from potential co-ordinators.

The Parish Council has co-opted Mrs Judith Walpole of Home Farm, Liscombe Park, to be a Parish Councillor replacing Mr. Marston. This appointment was made in the absence of requests for an election from the required number of Parishioners.

The Council continues to be represented at a multi-village forum pressing the need for the Wing, Linslade (Western) and Stoke Hammond by-passes. The Parish Council hope that as many as possible will attend the meeting on March 11th to make the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme benefit the Whole Village.

The next Parish Council Meeting will be on Monday 30th March.
