PARISH NEWS

The Parish Council meeting took place in the Parish Hall on Monday 20th February.

The next meeting is Monday 19th March at 19:30. All are welcome.

The Parish Council welcomed nine members of the public whose interests and comments covered various issues - proposed wind farm at Dorcas Lane, proposed large dwelling in Chapel Hill and the urgent need for yellow lines at Stockgrove Park entrance.

Proposed Wind Farm at Dorcas Lane: It has been suggested that the Parish Council organise a meeting for parishioners to air their views regarding the proposed wind farm at Dorcas Lane, inviting Force 9 Energy to attend. It seems the criteria for Force 9 Energy to accept an invitation is to install an independent chairperson. Previously a meeting was held for parishioners with regard to the Metmast application, which had a high attendance. However, there has not been the same opportunity with regard to the Wind Turbine application, whether one is in favour or not. There is very little time to organise this and to find an independent chairperson. We are not sure that details will be ready to include in this month's Newsletter, so please check the Parish Hall notice board regularly for further information.

Children's playground: We thank the two people who have volunteered to help with the installation of new playground equipment. We were expecting that more people would be interested in the improvements that we are trying to make to the Parish, especially for our younger members. If we have to pay for the installation of the equipment, this will take us over budget and it may not be possible to proceed. It has taken a lot of time for the Millennium Green Trustees and the Parish Council members to work out how the playground can best be sited, maintained, insured etc. and to research the equipment that we can afford. The equipment is up to date and the playground will be an extension to the existing play area on the Millennium Green. The whole play area will have new groundwork and new fencing. We felt that siting it on the Millennium Green was an easier route for mothers with younger children and the thought that mixed age groups use the Millennium Green may make it a sociable place for all. Remember, if these fields had not been secured as a green area, it would have been a housing estate, so let us use and enjoy it. Surely this is worthy of a little of your time and support. Please do not be afraid to volunteer. However little or however much you are able to do will be appreciated. This can be a sociable time too, where you may meet people you do not yet know. 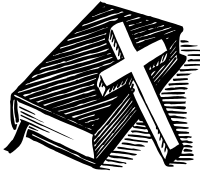
