Most of you may know that the County Council are very keen to encourage Adult Education. In the Wing area their representative is Dr. Alan Owen and he is based at the school. He already organises many courses in the school and the villages but would always be pleased to consider further developments. If you feel that you have an idea that you would like to be considered please contact him and he will be delighted to offer advice and help where possible......

I would be very pleased to meet any of you to talk about ways in which the school and the community can work closely together......I hope to hold a meeting during the Autumn inviting your view on various suggestions that have been made......I would like to meet as many of you as possible and I hope that we can work together to develop even further the work we already do here".
