Parish Council News

For a long time the Parish Council and the Church congregation have been very worried about the dangers of crossing the High Road at the entrance to the churchyard. After much discussion and various suggestions the County Council has agreed to make a pathway along beside the Churchyard wall down to the War Memorial. This point will make a much safer crossing place but it will involve moving the old wall back about one metre. It is proposed that the PCC and the Parish Council will share the cost of rebuilding the wall as it is felt to be such an important part of the village environment and the cost should not hinder this attempt to make the High Road safer for pedestrians. One way in which some money can be saved is to dismantle the wall and clean off the bricks using volunteer labour. It is hoped that the project will start some time in November and that there will be enough volunteers to make it possible.
