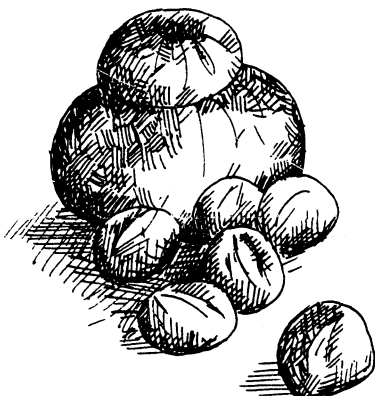


MISS LIZZY TURNEY
