Aylesbury-Milton Keynes Relief Road:

There will be a public meeting on Friday 3rd September at 8.00 pm in the Clubroom to enable parishioners to discuss with the Parish Council the County Engineer's proposals for the relief road, which are to be published on 1st September.

On Thursday 16th September the County Engineer's exhibition setting out the proposed routes in detail will be open to the public in the Clubroom from 2.00 pm until 9.00 pm.

We do urge as many people as possible to attend the meeting and inform themselves of the effect which the relief road is bound to have on Soulbury, and to consider the merits of the various proposals. Throughout the month of September members of the public and their representatives on the Parish Councils concerned are invited to express individual and collective reactions to the tentative schemes.
