

"DISCOVERING BUCKINGHAMSHIRE'S COUNTRYSIDE"



As the weather seems set fair for a bit longer we thought we would take the opportunity to mention some outdoor activities that are being organised in this locality. Bucks County Council have organised several walks with a theme, and on Thursday 6th September at 7.00 p.m. there will be a 3 mile evening wander discovering the rolling countryside of North Buckinghamshire. Catriona Mulligan, countryside officer, and Ivor Brent, a project officer will be leading the walk from the New Kingsbridge picnic site, north of Cublington (grid ref: SP 844 237).

On Sunday 9th September there will be a Claydon Woods circular walk, meeting at 10.45 a.m. near Knowlhill Farm for this 4 mile walk with an emphasis on practical conservation (grid ref: SP 708 238).

The local R.S.P.B. Group have just published their season's outings and events. Their first coach outing is to the North Norfolk coast on Sunday 23rd September, and on Saturday 15th September they will be meeting at Willen Lake to view waders, wildfowl and autumn migrants.

Stewkley "Rights of Way" Association has two walks in September. The first is the Drayton Parslow circular walk of 3½ miles leaving the Three Horseshoes at 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday September 5th (optional lunch on return). The other walk is an evening stroll on Sunday September 16th, leaving Chapel Square at 7.00 p.m. for a figure of 8 walk of 2½ miles.

For those who would like to walk nearer to home there is a local booklet, written and produced by Dave Miller, Lovett House, Soulbury, entitled 'Footpath Walks around Soulbury village.' The intention of the booklet is to make walking enjoyable and enabling the walker to find his/her way without prior knowledge of the area, and without resorting to a large scale map. There are seven circular walks, all starting at Soulbury Church; they vary from 1 mile in distance to 9 miles and many have short cuts. Most of the footpaths have been waymarked. The symbol is either a yellow arrow on a white circular disc or a white arrow shape. The proceeds from the booklet (price £1) will be donated to Florence Nightingale Hospice, and it is available, along with further details of all events mentioned from Mrs. Liz Miller, Lovett House, telephone 545.
