The beginning of July brings a brief respite in the life of students after GCSE and A level exams are over and before the long process of university/vocational/professional training - or just getting down to the beginning of a life of work!

It also marks the time when we remember 'doubting Thomas' in the Church. Poor old Thomas forever lumbered with this title and all because he missed the risen Jesus when He appeared to the other disciples in the upper room and showed them the scars in His hands and side.

Why wasn't Thomas with them? Was he too upset, confused or just in a sulk having felt he'd been misled in some way?



# Millennium Green News



# The Soulbury Millennium Green 'To Do' list for 2018

We will continue to leave this list in the Soulbury Parish News and as items are completed they will be crossed off. There is not a lot of crossing off just now due to vagaries of the weather. However, please offer any support you can. You will be welcomed with open arms.

## **Soil**

Shift soil to annex

Level pond edges (see pond)

Level chicken area/surrounding pathways

## **Work Area**

Rebuild-rear/side and annex pathways

Fix mower and barrows

## **Main Park Area**

Continuous seasonal mowing

## **Annex**

Remove top layer of turf for extended poppy beds (shape/size to be decided)

Replace top soil and compost

Plant Poppies/Foxgloves/Hollyhocks

Clear up rear woodland/remove dead wood

Chop down extra trees

## **Side Ponds**

Clear side pond area

Remove extra willow

Dig new pond holes (digger?)

## **Stage Area**

Clear memorial tree on right side

Clear and prune rear tree area

Plant conifers/Christmas tree on right hand side?

Ash tree to be pollarded

## **Woodlands**

Clear and maintain pathways

Rebuild and add wood chippings to pathways

Remove over seeded trees

Maintain woodland zones

## **Greenhouse Area**

Build Greenhouses

Cutback overhangs

## **Main Pond**

Level and shape pond edges

Clear under trees

Remove final stumps

Fix picnic bench to bottle neck pond edge

Tidy inner pond edges and remove debris

Hope for a liner! Pray if so inclined!

## **Bottleneck**

Repair and repaint exercise zone fence

Dig drainage pipe to pond

Either:

- Create new path between play area and exercise zone

- Join play area and work zone into one large area

## **Meadow**

Annual mowing

Maintain pathways

Cutback intruding Blackthorn and brambles on left hand side

Consider moving bonfire site 30 foot up meadow and reseed old bonfire site with British meadow flowers.

Clear dead wood and pathways in righthand woodland

Build new pathway on left hand side through Blackthorn area/clear original drainage channel

## **Orchard**

Annual mowing

Maintain and rebuild fruit beds

Level ground by toilet area

Replace a fruit tree or two (to be decided)

## Women's Institute

There was a good attendance at our June meeting and after the singing of Jerusalem, members were welcomed by our President, Jean Housley. It was good to see Greba at our meeting after her recent operation and we wish her well for the future. After the reading and signing of the minutes of last month's meeting, matters arising were dealt with. Val Hammond, the instigator of the croquet day, visited us for the evening, so the date is now settled and members are looking forward to an enjoyable time. Everyone agreed that last month's speaker, Hazel Foey, speaking on dental hygiene had covered her subject well, and we are now all brushing our teeth with extra care!

It was then time for Jean Housley to introduce our speaker for the evening, Marcelle Siddall. She helps to run Fancy Stitch which is a group of women living in Ingwavuma, which is in South Africa. The area where they live is poverty stricken and AIDS is prevalent resulting in a high mortality rate. This group of women use their artistic and exquisite embroidery skills to produce high quality goods including picture frames, key rings, greeting cards and bookmarks as well as a range of animals made from wire formers threaded with tiny beads. The income these women obtain from producing these goods is often the only source of income for them. A range of these items was on display and members were invited to purchase them, which they were only too eager to do! Marcelle was thanked for her enlightening talk by Chris Bryant who had herself visited South Africa, although not the same region, after which refreshments were served.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 3rd July which will be a Hobbies and Crafts evening. The meeting is a week earlier than normal as we will going on our outing on 10th July.

# Stan Morris

**Stan Morris 12<sup>th</sup> April 1930 to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2018**

It is with much sadness that we report the death of Stan Morris.

Many Soulbury villagers will remember him bustling round the village. He was Treasurer of All Saints' church and in the late 1990s was instrumental in a major restoration project partly funded by English Heritage. This led to the formation of the Friends of Soulbury Church to raise additional funds specifically for preservation of the fabric of the Church.

He could also be seen cutting grass round the village and organised the rota for other volunteers to do likewise using the village ride-on mower.

He was an active member of Leighton Buzzard Lions Club which organised the annual bonfire and fireworks display and Leighton Buzzard half-marathon among other fund raising and community events.

Before he retired he was General Manager/CEO of a local bus company. With this experience and together with Myrna Greene, he was instrumental in starting the Buzzer Bus Community Transport service in 1991, to serve Leighton Buzzard and surrounding villages. It is therefore sad that when AVDC withdrew their grants the Buzzer Bus stopped serving Soulbury and other Bucks villages leaving many old and vulnerable people stranded.

Together with his wife Jean he moved to the Bournemouth area in 2002 where he continued to be an active member of the local Lions Club, and also raised funds for the RNLI.

# Parish Council News

Apologies received from Cllr Ian Culley. Minutes of Parish Council previous meeting were approved. No matters arising.

Various accounts were paid.

## **Planning:**

There no planning applications on the AVDC website for Soulbury.

**Childrens playground:** This area is a mess and needs a concerted effort to bring it back to the previous standard.

**Grass cutting:** The Green is OK this time. However, a tree branch has dropped and needs cutting off.

**District Councillors:** Cllrs Neil Blake and Janet Blake were not present.

**Parish Hall:** Cllr Wright has organised for the front of the building is to be cleaned. Two new kettles have been bought. Cllr Wright will chase the acquisition of a fire door.

**Soulbury Millennium Green:** Preparing for Soulfest. A digger has been acquired for this weekend. The big marquee needs to be erected for 30 June and Cllr Stevens is looking for some help with this.

**Public participation:** It appears the new dog bin is not being emptied when all the rest are. It is well used so needs attention.

**Any other business:** The Battles Over, end of WWI celebrations are taking place on 11 Nov. The village will be involved in this so the beacon will be lit. It was suggested a committee be created to arrange catering, etc. Cllr Day will put an ad. for the parish news together so the village is aware of what is happening and to register the fact they want to join the buffet, etc. As the parish hall can only accommodate 60 it will be on a first come, first served basis. However, the event will be free and funded by the parish council.

Discussion took place around Great Brickhill parish council suggesting that 3 houses in Ivy Lane want to move to their parish from Soulbury. However, this does not appear to be the case when speaking to the residents. Clerk is to write to AVDC to object to any boundary changes.

The Christmas tree planted last year has now died. Cllr Stevens is sorting out a new one.

Cllr Day is obtaining a quote to sand blast the post for the finger sign.


