

Church Services

It is very sad to see our Church closed to all. We hope it can be opened again in the not too distant future, at least for short periods for private prayer/contemplation. Until then there are the practical issues of regular bills (such as insurance) to pay as well as urgent maintenance items. Recently we have had an electrical inspection to ensure the wiring is safe. This highlighted an out-of-date, and potentially dangerous, distribution board which has now been replaced. Storm Dennis also took its toll with significant damage to the south window of the tower. Unfortunately the window had already been highlighted as in a precarious state so we cannot make an insurance claim. Quotes obtained are about £1,800.

Although our finances are reasonably healthy due to a massive fundraising effort by Nadine Bonsor last year, this will not last for ever and we are missing collections taken at services. We are extremely grateful to those who already contribute regularly by standing order – both monthly and annually, but we would like to encourage both those who would normally attend services and put money into the collection (and of course anyone else feeling generous) to set up even a small monthly standing order.

Lockdown support

The Soulbury Helpers scheme is in place help those in self-isolation and in need of assistance. It works like this; leaflets will have been put through your doors by now with the name and contact number of a volunteer near you. Shopping was the biggest item that spurred on the introduction of the scheme, so here are a few of the rules. We cannot expect volunteers to use their own money to buy your shopping, so if you want shopping done you must be prepared to hand over CASH with your order. Needless to say a lot of trust on both sides must be displayed if this is to work. When goods are delivered to your door they will be left on your doorstep for you to take in. The person delivering will stand about 2 meters away and watch you collect your goods, they will not enter your house. Prescriptions are a bit easier - if you have them on a regular basis from a pharmacy in town, it is easy for someone to collect them and bring them to your door.

We have a trained counsellor in the village who, I'm sure, would willingly spare the time for a chat. Contact details can be passed on to you if needed.

We have 'tray bakes'. Nonna's is planning to provide smaller portions in addition to the usual sizes. These are ordered from Nonna's and delivered to the Parish Hall, see menu below.

We can do home delivery and we will take orders in advance, please contact Vic Wright.

A queue does form for the first hour, after which it is a steady flow.

By providing this shop it is hoped residents can stop leaving the parish to prevent succumbing to the virus thus saving the NHS a lot of extra work.

The Millennium Green is a place that I have not visited for the past few weeks as I am considered a vulnerable person. Not by me I might add!



May we remind everyone that the half yearly subscription of 15p for this issue of the Newsletter and the following five is now due.

April saw the passing of one of Soulbury's most notable characters, Mrs. Boyd Thomson in her ninetysecond year. She lived in Soulbury for over fifty years and was a fervent worker for the Church and was a founder member and Secretary of Soulbury Women's Institute which later disbanded. Mrs. Boyd Thomson was the widow of Mr. Glencairn Boyd Thomson who died in 1966; her only son Richard was killed in action in Burma during the War.




