

# Letter from our Team Vicar



Greetings and warm wishes to you all in this season of Eastertide.

At the point at which I was writing this contribution we were on the eve of the mid-April landmark for the new wave of restriction lifting, and there was clearly a strong sense of *déjà vu*. My mind was therefore drawn to something that was written back in May 2020 as the restrictions from the first lockdown were being lifted. The writing in question was from a book written by former Archbishop of Canterbury, Rowan Williams, in a book called *Candles in the Dark: Faith, Hope and Love in a Time of Pandemic* (the book that our Benefice Lent Group was focussing on back in February and March).

Writing on the eve of the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of VE Day Williams notes that, after six years of the deprivation and uncertainty of war, a sense of rest, a return to ‘normality’ and to something people could ‘cope with’ was clearly a top priority. However, it didn’t stop there, because many people did not consider it sufficient simply that the immediate threat was over. As Williams puts it, ‘for them, victory was about *opportunity*: something new had become thinkable.’ He notes the big changes that resulted in the social landscape of Britain as a consequence and speculates on what the modern-day possibilities for such a sense of opportunity might be, not least given the ongoing environmental urgency of our time.

As he too was writing in Eastertide, he was sure to relate this important focus on opportunity to an emphasis on Easter as a new beginning and not as an end – what he calls ‘an event that changes forever the landscape in which we live’. The key question, for him, is then whether we are ready and willing to take part in ‘whatever creative newness lies ahead’ so that we triumph not just over past dangers but also over our own longing for a restored sense of the usual and familiar. We can be liberated from a dependence on past comfort zones and open to new possibilities looking forward not backwards.

As this seems to ring true just as much, if not more, this year than last, it seemed only right to mention it again here – and I commend the book in question to any who may be interested in reading it.

With prayers and best wishes as we move forward together

# Parish Council News

The meeting of Soulbury Parish Council was held on Monday, 19 April 2021 at 7.30 p.m via Zoom due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions. There were 4 members of the public present. No apologies received. Wendy Taylor was asked to take the minutes of this meeting. Minutes of the meeting held on 15th March 2021 were approved. Matters arising covered the footpath in Hollingdon which has been much improved with the addition of some Type 2 ballast and 'Fix my Street' were contact about the road condition of The Mead but we were advised that 'no planned repair is necessary at this stage'. Various bills were paid.

## **Planning:**

## **Childrens' Playground:**

We have heard no more about the lease. It was due to be in effect by 25 March but Buckinghamshire Council has not confirmed in writing or asked for payment of rent yet. However, it was agreed for Frances Andrews and Karen Wood to go ahead and get quotes for play equipment. To this end 2 suppliers have made appointments to give quotes. Frances is having a problem contacting Wickstead.

## **Grass Cutting:**

Compliments have been received on the appearance of the village green.

Grass verge opposite Brooke Cottages cannot be cut due to damage by the builders in the Boot Field. Mr Pargeter has been approached by Cllr Wright.

Damage to the grass on the village green created by a Wickes delivery lorry will be repaired by Wickes.

## **County Councillors:**

No Councillor present.

## **Parish Hall:**

May elections: Cllr Rowe will inform Cllr Wright when the polling booths are to be delivered and when they will be collected.

## **SMG:**

The SMG is fine. A wooden post has been replaced in the childrens' play area and new gate has been made for the exercise playground.

Soulfest is planned for 10 July. A temporary event licence has been obtained. Pallets have been delivered by Lindsey Russell and her son to build the stage and she will arrange for more as they acquire them.

Richard Caplan has stressed that no fish are to be put/dumped/acquired for the pond as he is promoting newts.

Karen Wood is hiring one of of the SMG's marquees for her children's school event which will be returned in time for Soulfest. They will be collecting and erecting themselves.

## **Public Participation:**

Bridlepath gets extremely wet in two places and has been impassable at times. Part of this path is in Soulbury Parish and part in Stoke Hammond. It needs to be established in which parish the problem is. Cllr Day offered to walk the path to do this and ascertain the best solution for any problem in our parish.

Concern has been raised about the standard of build of properties in The Boot field. Some houses are in the wrong place, incorrect standard of timber used for partitioning, the white 'salts' are all over the bricks and the damage to the hedge along the High Road. The complainant is in the building trade and dealing with it. He will keep us informed of outcomes.

## **AOB:**

A tree is about to fall down in Bragenham Lane. Cllr Wright could not find it so has asked the Gt Brickhill parish clerk to advise him of its location. Cllrs Day, Stevens and Wright will inspect and remedy accordingly.

Cllr Stevens raised the issue that it appears people have bought a piece of land by railway bridge 141 by Chelmscote Cottages to gain access to the canal. There is a caravan and houseboat. A gate has been erected. They will need permission from Highways to get across their land. Cllr Stevens knows the person who sold the land, will get the details so the matter can be further addressed.

Speed Indicating Device outside 5 Leighton Road will be moved this week. Its pole will be refurbished by Cllr Cross.

Presentation to John Spires: Cllr Wright will inform John that it is our intention to make a presentation to him over a meal at a place of his choice.

Wendy Taylor advised that the next meeting will be when she takes over as parish clerk (temporary and unpaid at this time) so any items for the agenda will now need to come to her. Cllr Wright also agreed that a meeting be held with Wendy as there is a lot that needs to be handed over. Cllr Wright will also talk to John Spires regarding the handover.

## Soulbury Millennium Green





Sorry but it's not up to us to get rid of your rubbish, that is what the council is for and I don't mean the Parish Council!!



## Get Cooking!!

Lia is my Australian daughter-in-law. She and my son, Michael, live in Perth, Western Australia. They have four boys all in their twenties. One lives at home, the others turn up when they are hungry. This recipe is very easy, I have used it many times and although it serves two it can be adapted to any number of servings.

### Ingredients:

Baby spinach/lettuce mix

Blanched asparagus/beans

Tomatoes x 5, quartered

Proscuitto, 6 slices

Avocado x 1, sliced

Parmesan, shaved

Black pepper

Dressing:

Olive oil, 2 tablespoons

Lemon juice, 2 tablespoons

Sugar, 2 teaspoons

Fresh basil, chopped and lots of it.

### Method:

Bake tomatoes and proscuitto at 200 deg C for 20 minutes

Pile spinach, asparagus, tomatoes onto plate

Crumble proscuitto over the top

Pour over mixed dressing, then cove with parmesan and black pepper

This month there is to be a Flower Festival in the church and a Music Recital as part of a drive to raise the large sum of money which will be needed for church repairs. We thought that this month, therefore we would give a few points of interest about the church.

There is now nothing remaining of the building which must have been there in 1231 when the first rector of whom we know was appointed. The oldest extensive part of the present structure was built in the second quarter of the fourteenth century, at the beginning of the Hundred Years War; further additions were made later in that century and minor alterations were made in the fifteenth. There was major rebuilding in Tudor times when the aisles were extended and the tower added.

Some of the things to look for inside the church are the monument confidently ascribed to Grinling Gibbons, the doorway which used to give access to the rood loft, monuments to various members of the Lovett family who held the manor for over six hundred years, the padlocked chest and the little wooden angels appearing down the length of the Tudor roof. Two of the angels hold shields having the initials R H. These, almost certainly, are the initials of Robert Hobbes, Abbot of Woburn from 1529 to 1538 and therefore at that time ex-officio Vicar of Soulbury. Hobbes was one of the few who dared to oppose Henry the Eighth and suffered the usual fate of those who opposed the royal will. He was hanged on an oak tree at the gate of his own abbey which in the following year was confiscated and given to the Russell family. There is a board at the back of the church which gives the name of all the incumbents from that rector in 1231 to the present time.

In the course of the Festival a leaflet will be on sale which will give much more fascinating detail about the church.

## Timetable of Events in connection with the Flower Festival.

The church will be open from 10.00 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday, the 13th, 14th and 15th of May. On Saturday and Sunday refreshments will be served in the Clubroom from 3.30 - 5.00 p.m.

On Saturday there will be a recital in the church at 8.00 p.m. by a madrigal group and orchestra; Conductor, Charles Pope; Organist, Betty Pacey. Programmes for this will be on sale for 25p each. There will be refreshments in the Clubroom afterwards (cheese and wine, coffee, etc.)

## Guess Who?




