

## Letter from our Team Rector



Over the last 18 months we've become more aware of our inter-dependence and perhaps, our vulnerability, but hopefully we can now leave behind restrictions and restart our common life together. The Christian Gospel is clear that no-one is an island and whilst we are stronger together, we are strongest when we function as the body of Christ.

I used to know two brothers with a 1992 Ford Escort Cosworth rally car, once a Ford works car in the WRC. It has a bank of front lights, a roll cage from the front shock absorbers through to the rear ones, plus four wheel drive. The car's sides carry the bible verse "You must be born again".

We say Jesus is the light of the world. Just as the car's lights scatter the darkness, Jesus, in teaching and example, shows us the way, like a light.

The roll cage; there's times we feel crushed by our actions, inaction or simply at what is happening in the world. Christians believe that Jesus surrounds us so that we are not crushed.

And 4WD; life can be slippery, compromising. Well, you know where this is going – Jesus is like 4WD. When things get a bit questionable, Jesus teaches us what's right.

Being born again means I want Jesus in my life for all the above and more. Glib? I don't think so. Despite all the tech, that rally car is just like an ordinary car needing a battery, handbrake and unleaded. When we become a Christian, we're still us, but helped to see better, be stronger and be right with God; many ordinary people have thus done amazing things in Christ's name. Stepping into church might seem really hard, but the church is here for everyone and we'd love to see you.

# Parish Council News

The meeting of Soulbury Parish Council was held on Monday, 19 July 2021 at 7.30 p.m in the Parish Hall. There were 4 members of the public present. No apologies received Wendy Taylor due to self-isolate and Mrs Russell. Minutes of the meeting held on 21st June 2021 were approved. Various bills were paid. Matter arising comprised: Cllr Cross has made a plinth for the gift and will obtain engraved plaques, awaiting arrival of waste bin for childrens' playground. Various bills were paid.

Mr Nigel Kemal was invited to join the Council and was duly co-opted onto the Council by unanimous vote. He was welcomed by all those present

## **Planning:**

21/02224: Land adj Three Locks Ph, Leighton Road, Soulbury known as Waterside Barn - construction of a new detached double garage. No objection.

21/02786: Land at Stockgrove Park, Soulbury - erection of barn. No objection.

21/02674: Dairy Cottage, The Studio, Liscombe Park, Soulbury - Certificate of lawfulness application for single storey building and associated garden which has functioned as a separate residential dwelling. Council to object on the grounds of unlawful development, merely to show opposition to this type of 'creeping in' where an annexe is built and then years later is granted full status. The argument was put forward that Planning Laws have written in them that if no objection or enforcement has been made within the last ten years, then this appears to be a 'fait accompli'.

## **Childrens' Playground:**

It was agreed that the funding for the new equipment will be obtained from s106 monies we, as a parish, have accrued. Matched funding from a local waste company would mean the work could not start until December 2021 therefore became a non-starter as feelings were rife at the length of time the whole project is taking. Parish Council will fund the access provision for the less abled in the parish.

## **Grass Cutting:**

It was agreed that CS Maintenance would continue to mow the Soulbury Millennium Green as our mower is not really man enough for the task. It was also agreed that a council member would walk around the village with Richard (Heart and Soulbury Gardens) to establish what work needs to be done. Cllr Stevens will liaise with Richard.

## **County Councillors:**

No report as Cllr Jilly Jordan was unable to attend.

## **Parish Hall:**

The acquisition of solar panels on the roof of the parish hall was discussed and it was decided they were not necessary.

## **SMG:**

The Green is receiving comments on how good it is looking.

**Public Participation:**

Nothing brought forward.

Nothing brought forward.

**The Parish Council meeting will take place on 20 September 2021 at 7:30 pm in the parish hall.**






# Soulbury Millennium Green
